<p><b>Francis Nurse</b>          -Had petition put together w/91 names to clear wife</p>	<p><b>Giles Corey</b>          -brought evidence against Putnam          -Also brought deposition          -Says Putnam is killing neighbors for land          -Kept silent- gave no names</p>	<p><b>Rev.
